

LONG GRASS NOTICE

In preparation for summer, the City would like to remind all persons in possession of land whether landowner, lessee, renter, or tenant that there are resolutions and ordinances in place pertaining to the care of property in order to help maintain the health, safety, and appearance of our City.

GRASS

Grass must be cut before it is 9" tall in order to help prevent potential fire hazards, control mosquitos, and other insects or rodents while avoiding unsightly appearances. It is the responsibility of persons in possession of land to maintain boulevards, alleys, and ditches to the center of the street.

NOTICE

Written warning notices of a long grass or weed violation will be made upon any findings of failure, neglect, or refusal to maintain property.

VIOLATION

If the property has not been maintained within 5 days of the notice of violation, the City Public Works is authorized to pay for the mowing and/or removal of such long grass and/or weeds. The cost of such mowing and removal will be charged and assessed against the property.
